

Eco-dye Mini-Wreath – Evening Workshop - £25 including materials

ONLINE - Saturday 12 June, 10am – 4pm



Linda creates eco-dyed bundles of materials in her studio for mixed media projects. You will be supplied with your own kit in a choice of colourways enabling you to make your own mini-wreath from cotton which has been dyed in small batches using plant matter Linda has gathered from sustainable locations in Lincolnshire.

Created using simple knotting and tying techniques, the mini-wreath is suitable for indoor or fairly sheltered

use (these will stand up to weather but might just look pretty bedraggled if very wet!) and your kit will contain enough for you to experiment with knotting before going on to create the finished piece. The session will begin with a brief demonstration of basic eco-dyeing technique and a virtual tour of some of the plant locations before going on to use the dyed fabrics and materials provided.

Shown here with a glass test tube which is suitable for holding water so you can display fresh flowers and herbs, your kit will include a dried flower, leaves or seed-head for instant impact.

This workshop is suitable for the complete beginner, or more experienced maker alike.

You will need:

A flat surface with access to broadband and good lighting.

Some scissors and a ruler

A notebook or sketchbook

Some long-nosed pliers
